### The Hoop Revolution

While we at Hoola for Happiness truly love hooping for moments of happiness, we possess a deeper desire to translate those moments into a longerlasting condition of joy in our hearts and yours.

Thankfully, we serve a creative God who can use anything to further His kingdom. The hula hoop is the perfect tool for building relationships and spreading joy. Our goal is to send hula hooping missionaries all over the world who use hoops to connect to their communities. Hula hooping is an open door to knowing people, serving them and loving them the way Jesus does.

We take hoops to different organizations, unique people groups or just outside our back door to connect to one another and make the world a smaller place. Our hand-made hoops are donated to children across the globe, most of whom are orphans and have never seen a hula hoop before. We play games that encourage cooperation, boost self-esteem and promote creativity. The five colors on the hoop aid in sharing the story of Jesus and our testimonies of how He has changed our lives.



## Game Ideas and Activities



### 1. Circle of Life:

Have all members of the group form a circle while holding hands. Have two people lock hands through a Hoola for Life hoop. Now the fun begins! Try moving the hoop around the circle passing over and under each person without unlocking hands until the hoop makes its way all the way around.

### 2. Leap of Faith:

Jump through the Hoola for Life hoop at various levels. Hold the hoop for others while they jump or dive through. Unless you're a trained circus professional, be careful with the diving.

### 3. Hoop Toss:

Set up targets using cones or other items. If you don't have spare cones, you can use each other. Stand at various distances and toss the hoop, trying to ring the hoop around the person or target.

### 4. Monkey in the Middle:

Have a group form a circle with each person standing inside the hoop. Place one person in the middle as the "monkey." Play music to indicate when to move. When the music starts, everyone must switch hoops with someone else quickly while the monkey tries to jump in a hoop. Whoever is left without a hoop to stand in is the new monkey.

### 5. Relay Race:

Establish two teams, a starting line and a finish line. Have two teams race to the finish line and back while hooping. Pass the hoop to the next team member and repeat. If that's too easy, place obstacles in the race path or try incorporating other hoop tricks.
